Art Class Supplies List: Items needed for class

When purchasing art supplies, I recommend Crayola or Prang products. Reason for this is the cheaper the product the more additive and less pigment. For example, water sets that are cheaper in price have flour or cornstarch added and less pigment. This leads to needing to use more to achieve a brighter color. In crayons you will find that more wax is used than pigment. Even with #2 pencils and erasers there are such fillers as wax and glue. When buying product with fillers you end up using more of the product and having to purchase twice or three times or more of the product. In the end you are spending more for less quality.

Most of these items will be on sale during the months of July and Aug.

Supplies needed for class are:

Watercolor set (8 cake) recommend Prang

48 color box of crayons (recommend Crayola)

2- White Vinyl Erasers

1 package of construction paper

Set of Thin and broad markers (recommend Crayola)

Set of colored pencils (recommend Crayola)

1 bottle of White glue
